We're the UK government's international scholarships and fellowships programme.


We provide the education, network, and confidence to support you to build a better future.

#### Follow these steps to apply:

- Visit Chevening.org/find-a-course to find three different eligible UK master's courses.
- 2. Apply directly to your chosen UK universities.
- 3. At the same time, visit Chevening.org/apply to apply for a Chevening Scholarship.
- Apply early in the application period to avoid disappointment.

# You must meet the following eligibility criteria to apply. You must:

- Be a citizen of a Chevening-eligible country (visit Chevening.org/apply to find out if your country is listed)
- Agree to return home for a minimum of two years after completing your degree
- Have an undergraduate degree enabling you to apply for a postgraduate course at a UK university
- · Have at least two years' work experience
- Not have previously studied in the UK through a government-funded scholarship
