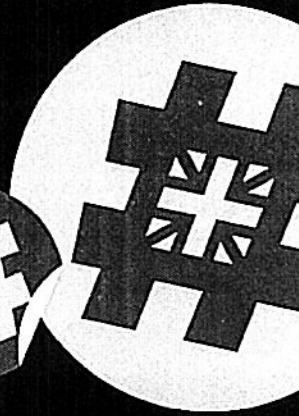

HOW DO I APPLY?



Follow these steps to apply:

1. Visit [Chevening.org/find-a-course](https://chevening.org/find-a-course) to find three different eligible UK master's courses.
2. Apply directly to your chosen UK universities.
3. At the same time, visit [Chevening.org/apply](https://chevening.org/apply) to apply for a Chevening Scholarship.
4. Apply early in the application period to avoid disappointment.
5. Recommend Chevening to your friends and colleagues by tagging them on social media using #MyFriendsAcheveningScholar.

AM I ELIGIBLE?

You must meet the following eligibility criteria to apply.

You must:

- Be a citizen of a Chevening-eligible country
(visit Chevening.org/apply to find out if your country is listed)
- Agree to return home for a minimum of two years after completing your degree
- Have an undergraduate degree enabling you to apply for a postgraduate course at a UK university
- Have at least two years' work experience
- Not have previously studied in the UK through a government-funded scholarship

There is no upper age limit.
